FONVILLE PRESS HISTORY

John Fonville was born in 1910 on a farm in Alabama and was raised by a great aunt. In elementary school, he was an avid reader and good student. In fourth grade, he was inspired to write a book which began his preoccupation with book writing. As a young man, he inherited an appointment as a Page in the Alabama House of Representatives from his older brother and was later elected as a Senate Page.

Upon graduation from high school, John realized the Great Depression had stripped away family support so he began working as a bank clerk to save money to attend Auburn University. He worked his way through college and became President of the Student Body. He graduated with a textiles engineering degree and joined a cotton mill in South Carolina where he met his wife, Ellie. Later, while working as a publisher in Atlanta, his career was interrupted by four years of military duty in World War II. Upon his return, he became the editor of a magazine.

At age 35, John gave his employer ten years notice of his retirement. In 1953, he and Ellie began exploring the roads of North Florida when they discovered a newly paved road leading to the Gulf and a development named Seagrove Beach. They purchased three lots just one block from what is now highway 30A and 395. In 1956, they built their home and moved to Seagrove where he served as Justice of the Peace. Surrounding them were just a few cottages and lots of untouched gulf front.

Of special interest to John were the few children who resided year around and those who migrated in for the summer. To their delight, his yard featured several swings, a tree house, and a cable slide - the original Fonville Park.

The Stephens family, developers of Alys Beach, and John Fonville were Seagrove neighbors for many decades. To be good, to be giving, to be a good citizen, and to be a good friend...therein all the honor lies. With Fonville Press, we honor a true gentleman.
